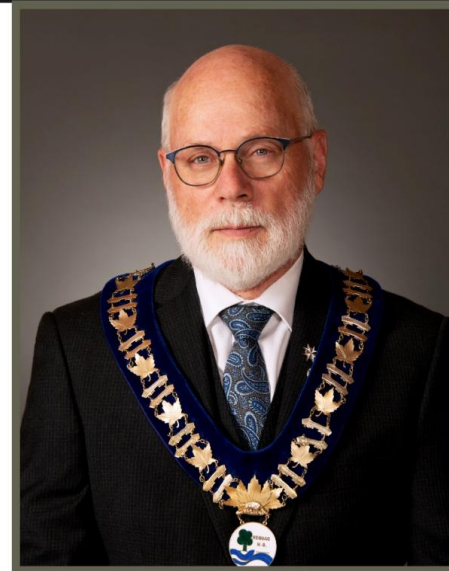

COUNCIL DECISIONS

- That the municipality accepted a \$10,000 grant from the province to undertake the necessary steps to obtain “Dark Sky” designation and to become part of a Canadian network for astronomical observation at the Otho House site and Hay Island

- That the municipality accepted a donation of equipment valued at approximately \$8,000 from the province to assist the fire department in fighting forest fires.

- That the municipality accepted a \$10,000 grant from the province to continue its climate change adaptation efforts with the Valores team.



AMENDMENTS TO BY-LAWS

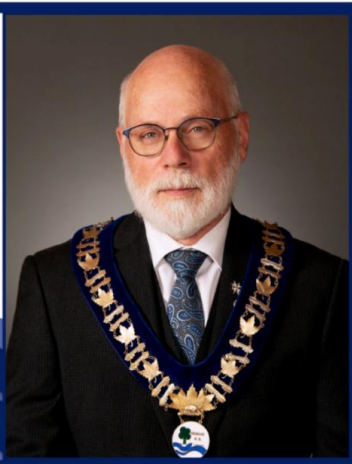
- Council adopted By-laws 15-2026 and 99-33-16A. These by-laws are intended primarily to amend the zoning provisions and the rural plan by expanding the Industrial (I) Zone into part of the Mixed (MI) Zone in order to permit the use of a scrapyard or salvage storage yard in the industrial park.

Tourist Accommodation Fee

The municipality wishes to inform tourist accommodation operators that Council has adopted the by-law respecting the tourism accommodation levy, a measure intended to support tourism development and promotion in the region.

This 3.5% levy applies to any rental of one (1) accommodation unit or more for a period of 31 days or less. It is payable by the guest and must be collected by the operator at the time of the transaction, in addition to being shown as a separate item on the invoice. Collection will begin in May 2026. Operators must then submit quarterly returns, with the first due at the end of June 2026, even if no revenue was generated.

Operators may now visit the CSRPA website, under the Services Offered section, to register their accommodation and eventually submit their returns.



Construction work on Route 11

The Municipality of Neguac would like to advise residents that construction of a pedestrian crossing will take place on Route 11 between Richelieu Park and the Tourism Centre, beginning on May 18 and continuing until early June. For everyone's safety, we ask that you use caution when travelling near the work area. The municipality thanks you in advance for your understanding and patience.

A New Employee Joins the Municipality

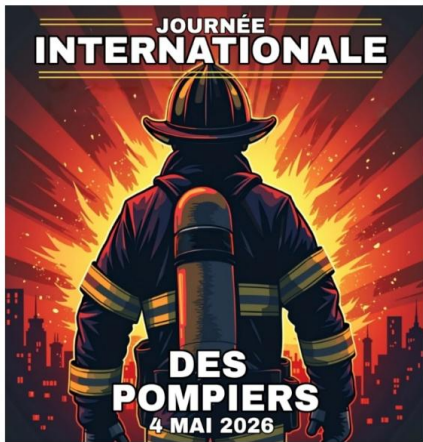
The municipality is very pleased to welcome Mr. Jeremy Savoie to its municipal staff team.

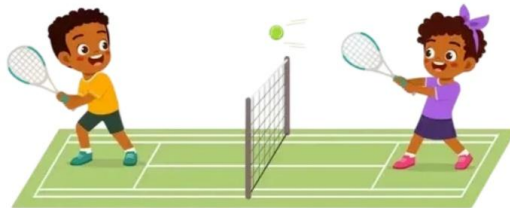

Fresh For Less is a community program that uses bulk purchasing to offer monthly bags of fresh fruits and vegetables at an affordable price. The program is open to everyone. Our goal is to make fruits and vegetables more accessible and to support the health of our community members.

The bags usually contain potatoes, carrots, onions, apples, oranges, and bananas. Other foods are added depending on the season and availability. The cost of a bag is \$20 (estimated retail value of \$50 or more).

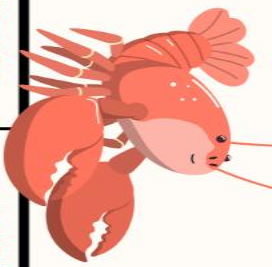
